job readiness and life skills—while providing the spiritual support of Bible study and mentoring from Christian men.

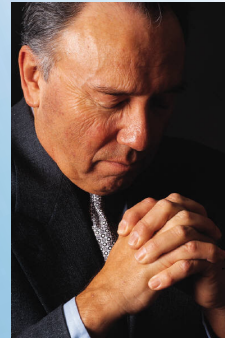
Self-sufficiency is the goal for all CMJC participants. Through CMJC the men will become believers in themselves and, through Bible study, in Jesus Christ.
