

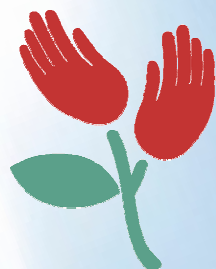
Women Helping Women

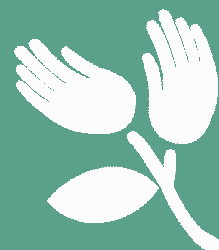
